Overview:

The Sophos Certified Administrator program is designed exclusively for Sophos customers. The goal is to enable Sophos customers and end users to become certified on Sophos products. Sophos Partner must register for a partner training of the Sophos Partner Program. This customer training course is designed for technical professionals who will be managing Sophos Central and provides the skills necessary to manage the different Sophos Central products. It consists of presentations, simulations and practical lab exercises to reinforce the taught content, and electronic copies of the supporting documents for the course will be provided to each trainee through the online portal. The course is expected to take 2 days to complete, of which approximately half will be spent on the practical exercises.

Target Audience:

This course is designed for technical professionals who will be planning, installing, configuring and supporting deployments in production environments. And for individuals wishing to obtain the Sophos Central Certified Engineer Certification

Prerequisite:

There are no pre-requisite for this course, however it is recommended that students should:

- Be able to setup a Windows server, with Windows workstations
- Have knowledge of general Windows networking and Microsoft Active Directory

- Recognize the main technical capabilities of Sophos Central and how they protect against threats
- Identify the solution components and understand how they interact
- Use Sophos Central Admin to configure the different Sophos Central products
- Deploy Sophos Central client components
- View, manage and interpret logs and reports using the Sophos Central Admin
- Complete common day-to-day tasks
- Perform basic troubleshooting
- Locate and use additional online resources
- Gather information that will assist investigation by Sophos Support
